Tivoli... Following a public forum to discuss drug awareness in the Village of Tivoli, Deputy Mayor Bryan Cranna called the forum very informative, and a step in the right direction to address drug use within Tivoli.

The forum hosted by Cranna, was presented by Village of Red Hook Police Department Officer in Charge, Patrick Hildenbrand, and Dutchess County Sheriff Deputy, Todd Grieb.

Discussed in the forum which was attended by village residents, parents, and village officials, was what signs residents should look for if they suspect drug use or sales. Both police agencies discussed what they are currently doing within the village to negate the problem, and remove users, buyers, and sellers from Tivoli.
