Tivoli Board Meetings to go on the Road

Tivoli... Village of Tivoli Mayor Bryan F. Cranna announced that the upcoming Board of Trustees meetings will be going on the road. Bringing back a prior tradition that existed when Cranna was a Trustee and begun by then former Mayor and now State Assemblyman Marc Molinaro, the next three board meetings will take place away from village hall.

According to the Mayor, the board meeting scheduled for August 17th at 7PM will take place in Tivoli's Memorial Park, September's board meeting will take place at Provoost Park, and a location for October's meeting will be announced soon.

Mayor Cranna stated, "I'm happy to bring this tradition back to the village. Hosting meetings away from village hall and actually out within our village often times generates some more interest in our meetings and allows for another opportunity to residents to be part of their government."

Cranna continued, "Hosting August's meeting in Memorial Park is fitting as we are about to begin a very much needed face lift for the park. Due to a Dutchess County Community Development Block Grant of \$100,000 that Tivoli secured, work is about to begin on; making our bathrooms handicapped accessible, placement of new playground equipment, improvements to our pavilion, and drainage in the ball field."

Chairs will be available in the park the night of the meeting, so there is no need for residents to bring their own.

Cranna concluded by saying, "I sincerely hope that residents come out and attend these meetings. I believe that moving the meetings away from village hall and out within the public is yet another step for this village promoting open government."
